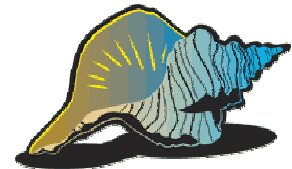
Insect Discovery

Under the Sea

Session 1: June 13 - July 1 (3 weeks): Insect Discovery

Theme songs: Here is the Beehive & Lady Bug, Lady Bug

Children will discover many facts about insects. Some critters are harmless and they are essential to our ecosystem. Children will be excited as they get real-life and hands-on experiences with ladybugs, monarch butterfly and ants in the classroom! Education specialist of “Insect Discovery Lab of San Francisco” will give presentation on Wed, June 22nd. Children will get hands-on experience by touching grasshoppers, beetles, millipedes, walking sticks and more!

Session 2: July 5 – July 29 (4 weeks): Rainforest Exploration

Theme songs: God Made Everything Good

Rainforest covers about 6% of the world. Amazingly, it is believed about 50% of the world’s species of plants and animals live in the rainforest! Children will learn about Toucan, Jaguars, Dart Frogs, Giant Armadillos, Squirrel Monkeys, etc. And how we can make a difference to protect God’s wonderful creations!

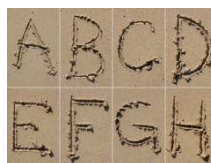
You and your child will have an opportunity to contribute in a Coin Drive. Every \$50 we collected will help protect an acre of the rainforest!
